

Capabilities of ECS Mobile

ECS Mobile is a browser-based interface that can be used to access your ECS system on devices with a smaller form-factor. Depending on your ECS configuration, it is most suitable for the following functions listed in the table below. ECS Mobile is meant to be a companion app and not a replacement for the full desktop version.

The list below does not cover every feature of ECS or ECS Mobile. It is a list of commonly used features meant to contrast ECS Mobile to the full version of ECS. In addition, it is important to note that although items below have a checkmark in ECS Mobile, this does not guarantee that all functions within the module will work in ECS Mobile. This is because ECS is customizable and a facility may have customizations that will not work within the ECS Mobile interface.
